## Report

- **1.** The idea of our Commission was to create the Chapter of the Technical Matters as the manual (guide) for organisers of different level tournaments was accepted by participants of the meeting.
- 2. All organisers will find in our Chapter the proper equipment, chess game notation (paper and electronic score sheets), chess tables, tournament halls with requirements on treatment of disabled chess players and school tournaments, prepared regulation of Round- Robin and Swiss tournaments, rate of play in the different competitions, broadcasting, dress code, tie-break regulations as well as the Berger and Varma tables (restricted drawing of lots) and many details.
- **3.** Many TEC members have drawn the attention to a few parts in the Chapter and proposed corrections and additional information. Most of the proposed changes were accepted.
- **4.** The TEC is very thankful to GM Victor Bologan and IA Sava Stoisavljevic for many very important remarks and corrections concerning the Electronic score sheet. All of them were added to the final text.
- Remarks regarding the ordinary notation of the game and rate of play proposed by WGM Zhaoqin Peng and WGM Agnieszka Brustman were also added.
